

Course Syllabus Intaglio 102

This course explores advanced intaglio techniques. It is intended for those that already took Intaglio 1 and are looking into understanding advanced techniques. It is an introduction to the use of light (instead of line and tone) in printmaking. We will cover the three basic techniques: mezzotint, roulette and burin. In this course we will go through the works of great masters as well as the work of contemporary printmakers working in these techniques.

Objectives

The purpose of this course is to prepare the participant to be fluent in the use of light in these three advanced intaglio techniques mentioned above. Participants will have a chance to work in different tools on copper matrices. Participants will understand how to use light in intaglio in order later development of their projects in printmaking.

This course is divided in two parts:

1. **Theory:** covers philosophy of the artworks as a multiple, as well as the works of master printmakers.
2. **Practice:** projects you will produce and present.

Learning Outcomes

At the end of the course the student will be able to:

1. **Understand** the use light in producing an image in intaglio
2. **Understand** the tone in printmaking
3. **Explore** advanced intaglio as a form of representation
4. **Define** terms and theory in intaglio processes
5. **Explore** philosophy and reading the printed image through the works of master printmakers
